

## **E-File (VJEFS)**

The Lee County Clerk of the Circuit Court through the Virginia Judiciary e-filing System (VJEFS) will allow electronic filings in most civil cases.

VJEFS is a comprehensive automated system developed by the Office of the Executive Secretary to integrate with the circuit court clerks' offices' existing statewide Circuit Case Management, Case Imaging, and Financial Management Systems, thereby improving the efficiency of the clerks' offices.

VJEFS is an automated filing system developed by the Supreme Court of Virginia, Office of the Executive Secretary that integrates with the Circuit Court Clerk's existing Case Management, Imaging and Financial Management Systems. This enhanced accessibility will maximize productivity and improve efficiency for the Circuit Court Clerk's Office and the local attorney. E-filed cases requiring service should include a letter advising how the parties are to be served and by whom. If copies are to be made by the Clerk's Office for service, additional fees of \$.50 per page will be added. To avoid the additional fees, copies may be sent to the Clerk's Office for service.
